Today marks a pivotal step in our commitment to an AI-first future. After serving more than 130,000 users and becoming the backbone of enterprise energy & sustainability programs worldwide, we are proud to announce the launch of Resource Advisor+—our next-generation, AI-native platform designed to meet the complex demands of the future.

While EcoStruxure™ Resource Advisor (now referred to as Resource Advisor Classic) has been the trusted answer for years, the speed of regulatory change and the depth of intelligence required for meaningful energy and sustainability management now demands a new architectural foundation. Resource Advisor+ is that foundation: a single, unified platform that will eventually house our entire suite of sustainability and energy solutions, powered by our proprietary SE Advisory Intelligence, a specialized domain-focused knowledge layer.

A Phased Journey: What's Launching & When

We are taking a phased, multi-year approach to ensure every client is supported, successful, and empowered to move at their own pace.

We are rolling out the Resource Advisor+ family of sustainability products in waves throughout 2026 to ensure stability and value at every step. Initially the products will be available in the United States and Europe with LATAM and APMEA to follow.

- January 2026 (Available Now): *Carbon Performance and Supply Chain*.
- April 2026: *Reporting & Compliance*.
- June 2026: *Climate Risk*.
- Future Priority (2027+): Energy Management and Efficiency solutions.

What This Means for Your Current "Resource Advisor Classic" Experience

We know change brings questions. Here's some guidance to help you reflect on how you're currently using the Resource Advisor platform and what that might mean for you going forward. We encourage you to have a conversation with your client manager for specifics.

1. For Energy Management & Efficiency Users

If your primary use of Resource Advisor is for energy procurement, bill management, or efficiency projects, your experience will not change in 2026. These products will remain in the "Classic" experience for the year. We are prioritizing these workflows for future development on the new Resource Advisor+ platform and will share a roadmap for that transition at a later date.

2. For Emissions Management Users

For clients currently using Resource Advisor Emissions Management, we are making a shift. As of January 20, 2026, we will no longer sell the Classic Emissions Management product to new accounts in North America and Europe.

- **The Opportunity:** The new Carbon Performance product on Resource Advisor+ is live and represents a significant leap forward in capability compared to Classic Emissions Management. Not only does it add Scope 3 measurement capability, it also helps teams assess, prioritize, and manage decarbonization projects with scenario modeling and progress tracking. We encourage you to explore this for your 2026 or 2027 strategy.
- **The Choice:** You will not be forced to migrate in 2026. If you are happy with your current deployment, you can remain on Classic for now. Moving to Carbon Performance is considered a new product deployment and will require a contract adjustment; it is not an automatic upgrade. If you are interested in exploring a move, please contact your Client Manager to discuss your options further.

Navigating the Change: Frequently Asked Questions

We want to be transparent about what this journey looks like for you. Below are answers to the most common questions regarding the transition.

- **Will you be requiring me to migrate to Resource Advisor+ products?**

For 2026, the answer is no. We are not requiring migrations for existing Resource Advisor Emissions Management or Energy Management clients this year. We want you to move when the value is clear for your organization.

- **If so, when? How much time do we have to prepare?**

While there is no required migration in 2026, we envision Resource Advisor+ will eventually become the standard for all clients. We are committed to providing an adequate notice before "end of life" for any Classic experience.

- **Will I have to amend existing contracts to move to Resource Advisor+?**

Yes. Because Resource Advisor+ products (like Carbon Performance) are rebuilt entirely with new capabilities and architecture, adopting them will require either a contract amendment or a new agreement. RA+ licenses are not direct 1:1 substitutions with legacy RA Classic licenses.

- **Is Resource Advisor+ really better than Resource Advisor?**

Yes. Aside from speed and user experience improvements, the core difference is SE Advisory Intelligence. At the architectural core of the Resource Advisor+ platform is our proprietary knowledge layer. When Resource Advisor+ makes a recommendation, it is reasoning from thousands of real-world projects, regulatory nuances, energy conversion logic, and proven operational patterns. It augments your expertise with our consulting heritage in a way the Classic platform cannot.

- **Do you have any customers using products on the Resource Advisor+ platform?**

Yes. We are in an active Beta Program for the Carbon Performance product and various clients are already using the Supply Chain product.

- **Will my support / client management model be changing?**

Resource Advisor+ will come with a default level of support provided by an in-house customer success team. Users requiring their existing level of advisory support or a higher degree of customer support than is offered in the default level, can elect to purchase optional value-added service package

- **If my company wants to move from Resource Advisor Emissions Management and buy the Carbon Performance product, how will you help us migrate?**

Any client who buys Resource Advisor+ will require an implementation phase; however, every client's situation is unique. We will work together with your team to discover what is required for your specific implementation to ensure a smooth transition, acknowledging we are not starting from the beginning since you are a current user of Emissions Management.

- **How will data connectivity work between Resource Advisor Classic and Resource Advisor+ products?**

By design, Resource Advisor Classic and Resource Advisor+ are designed to work together, so you can benefit from new Resource Advisor+ capabilities without losing continuity in your existing energy and efficiency workflows. We've built a bridge API that lets key datasets flow between Resource Advisor Classic modules and Resource Advisor+ products, creating a connected, portfolio-wide view while you operate in a hybrid environment.

- **What about our data privacy?**

Our systems are designed with multiple layers of security – from network segmentation and firewalls to encryption and access control – to ensure that even if one layer is compromised, others continue to protect data. All data is encrypted end-to-end. Furthermore, we continuously monitor for unusual activity using automated alerts, anomaly detection and independent auditing tools to identify and respond to threats in real time.
